Delhi-bound SpiceJet flight returns to Pune due to technical glitch

A SPICEJET flight from Pune to Delhi was diverted back to Pune on Monday after takeoff due to a technical glitch.

The flight did not make an emergency landing, the airline clarified in a statement.

On Monday, the Boeing 737-800 aircraft took off from Pune at 6:40am against the scheduled time of 6am. It reached near Valsad in Gujarat before making a u-turn to return to Pune, according to flight data recorded on website Flight Radar 24. It arrived back over the Pune airport at 7:30am, after which it circled over the airport for over 30 minutes, before landing at 8:10am.

The flight reached a maximum altitude of 29,000 feet. Later in the day, the same flight was to travel from Delhi to Darbhanga at 9:20 am.

Following take off, the 'flap transit light' in the flight was illu-

minated, which led pilots to take the call to return to Pune as a precautionary measure.

According to a document by the European Union Aviation Safety Agency, the primary purpose of the amber 'LE FLAP TRANSIT' indication is to indicate failure of the leading edge flap system.

Speaking to The Indian Express, a Spicejet spokesperson said, "Spicejet flight SG 937 on September 1, 2025, operating from Pune to Delhi, returned to Pune shortly after take-off. Following take-off, the flap transit light illuminated, and the operating crew carried out all necessary checks in accordance with standard operating procedures. As a precautionary measure, the pilots decided to return to Pune. The aircraft landed safely and passengers deplaned normally. The aircraft did not make an emergency landing. Affected passengers are being accommodated on alternate flights or offered full refunds."

DRDO facility develops underwater signalling flares for Kalvari-class submarines

HIGH ENERGY Materials Research Laboratory (HEMRL), a premier facility of the Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) in Pune, has successfully developed an underwater signalling system 'Signal Star Naval Flare' for deployment on Kalvari-class submarines of the Indian Navy.

At the handing over ceremony held last week, the HEMRL formally delivered the system to the Director General of Naval Armament Inspectorate. "This achievement marks a significant step towards Atmanirbhar Bharat in the field of critical defence pyrotechnics," said a statement issued by the Ministry of Defence.

The Signal Star Naval Flare is a

specially designed underwater signaling device, tailored to the demanding operational needs of submarines. It is ejected from the submarine's signal ejector, travels through the water column, and activates upon surfacing. Once at the surface, the flare ignites a high-intensity pyrotechnic charge, producing a bright, star-like light visible at long ranges—even at night or in adverse weather.

The flare is housed in a pressure-resistant casing, ensuring reliable operation even under high underwater pressures. On reaching the surface, hydrostatic mechanisms initiate the flare's functioning. A specially formulated pyrotechnic composition produces bright red or green star signals, depending on the tactical requirement. These colors are standardized for naval communication.

Marathi medium schools oppose Hindi title of Centre's initiative

MAHARASHTRA GOVERNMENT'S order asking schools to celebrate a Central government initiative—Hamara Vidyalay, Hamara Swabhiman—aimed at cultivating value-based outlook towards life among children has sparked a new debate over its title which is in Hindi.

Many have opposed the initiative's title, arguing that the majority of government-run and aided schools, where this will be applicable, are Marathi medium schools and thus should have the title in Marathi language.

Government-run and aided schools in Maharashtra are asked to conduct Hamara Vidyalay, Hamara Swabhiman initiative on September 1, wherein students and teachers will collectively take a pledge for holistic development of the schools and its students. This initiative aims to cultivate in students a value-based outlook to-

wards life, promoting discipline, national spirit, social harmony, care for school resources, and compliance with civic duties. In districts where schools are closed on Monday due to the festival, they are asked to conduct the initiative on September 2.

But the initiative's Hindi title has sparked a new debate over the state's insistence on Hindi. Sushil Shejule, coordinator of the Marathi School Management Association, said, "Just a few months ago, the Hindi language debate had forced the state government to review its decision. Yet its insistence on Hindi continues. There is no opposition to the initiative, but the state can rename it in Marathi language so that schools and students can relate to it."

Shejule highlighted that the majority of state-government-run and aided schools are Marathi medium schools.

Whereas Mahendra Ganpule, from Maharashtra State School Principals' Association, pointed out that recently various such Central-gov-

ernment initiatives are implemented in the state with their Hindi title.

"Initiatives such as 'Ek ped ma ke naam', 'Meri Mitti', have been implemented in the state with the same titles, due to which questions are raised on Hindi's insistence by state government, especially after recent controversy over including Hindi as third language in schools," he said. Schools have also pointed out that conducting such initiatives has only led to an additional burden of co-curricular activities as the majority of them are duplications of existing initiatives run by the state government.

"State government is already implementing—Mazi Shala Sundar Shala—where schools conduct activities that promote cleanliness, health and hygiene along with environmental conservation to foster a sense of responsibility among students. Whereas Mazi Shala Mazi Parasbag initiative includes planting trees to develop a garden in school," said Shejule.

Contractor dies by suicide over pending dues in Nagpur; 2nd such death in two months

A NAGPUR-BASED contractor, identified as Munna Verma, a resident of Raj Nagar, was found dead in his home on Tuesday. Police said Verma allegedly died by suicide.

His friends said he took the extreme step reportedly over mounting debts and delays in receiving payments for completed government projects.

According to police, Verma's friends had gone to meet him in the morning and found his house locked.

With his family away in Hyderabad, they took a spare key from the building's guard and entered the house, where they found Verma dead.

His body was sent to Indira Gandhi Government Medical College, also known as Mayo Hospital, for post-mortem. His family is returning to Nagpur, Sadar police said.

Sources close to Verma said he had been working as a contractor in Nagpur for over 30 years and had contracts with the Public Works Department (PWD), Nagpur Municipal Corporation (NMC), and Zilla Parishad.

He had pending dues of over Rs 30 crore. He also owned a hot-mix plant in Wardha. People close to him said he had been disturbed over prolonged delays in payments.

The incident has brought attention to complaints of pending contractor dues.

This is the second such suicide by a contractor in state in the past two months.

Friends of Verma said he was in Chandrapur during last week's "bheek mango andolan" staged by contractors demanding payment clearance, and he appeared stressed over phone.

Sadar police have registered a case and are investigating the matter further.

DRUG SMUGGLING CASE

SUV, 3 bank accounts, land belonging to drug kingpin to be attached

AN SUV, three bank accounts and a land parcel in Pune belonging to an alleged drug kingpin will soon be attached by the law enforcement agencies following a drug smuggling case.

The alleged kingpin, identified as Vikram Kunjir, along with four others were arrested by the Narcotics Control Bureau (NCB) last year for allegedly running a ganja racket whereby they procured ganja from Odisha border and supplied it in Pune.

As per NCB, the office of Competent Authority confirmed the orders of attachment issued by them concerning the movable and immovable properties worth Rs 2.36 crore of a kingpin who was found involved in smuggling of ganja. The seized movable properties include three bank accounts and one Mahindra Thar vehicle while immovable properties include a piece of land at Uruli Kanchan in Haveli taluka in Pune.

The matter pertains to seizure of 111 kg of ganja at Pathardi Road, Ahilyanagar by NCB leading to the arrest of five persons including Kunjir who NCB says was the kingpin. The drug was found sourced from Andhra-Odisha Border area and was destined to Pune. The kingpin and mastermind operating this inter-state drug syndicate from Pune was arrested. He was subsequently released on bail.

An NCB official said, "While Kunjir was subsequently released on bail, four others are behind bars." He added, "We have actively taken efforts to hit the drug suppliers financially so as to dismantle drug networks. Hence, even though the accused may eventually come out on bail, attachment of property acts as a deterrent against them."

As per procedure, the NCB seeks attachment of property obtained from proceeds of crime which then has to be confirmed by the competent authority following which the process of attachment takes place.
